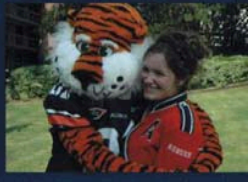

The Auburn University Band Department is proud to offer the 2008-09 Marching Band CD. This year's band is part of a long and proud tradition that has, for 111 years, represented Auburn University and the state of Alabama with pride, precision, discipline, and energy. The marching band is comprised of students from across the United States and its members represent virtually every discipline on campus.

The 2008-2009 season, filled with successful performances and new accolades, was another huge success for the tradition-rich AUMB. The band took the field for the third straight year with over 350 members. Early in the season, the AUMB was one of only seven bands in the country to be included in the ESPN and Paramount Pictures "Battle of the Bands," which resulted in a \$5000 prize. The AUMB's rendition of the Indiana Jones theme music was presented on ESPN.com and finished third in the online voting contest. During the week of Auburn's home game against LSU, the band was featured on the popular television segment ESPN Roadtrip. In addition, the AUMB Drumline was honored with an endorsement from Pearl Drums Corporation, who will provide new equipment for the percussion section each fall.

During the 08-09 season, the band performed a variety of halftime shows, in addition to the traditional pregame show, designed to entertain fans of all ages. The AUMB opened and closed the season with a tribute to one of the world's most enduring and legendary rock bands, The Rolling Stones. On the heels of its award-winning trip to Ireland, the AUMB performed a collection of Celtic classics for its second show of the 2008 season. The show included a shamrock formation by the band, along with Irish fiddlers, a video montage of the band's trip overseas, and shamrock and Irish national flags. To salute the always-energetic Auburn student section, the band presented a collection of popular sing-alongs that included music by Lynyrd Skynyrd, Journey, and Bon Jovi. Much of the music from the Fall 2008 halftime shows is included on this disc, along with many of the popular selections used to cheer on the tigers each Saturday in Jordan Hare. We hope you enjoy this year's recording.
