## Directors of the AU Marching Band

**Mr. Troy Breaux** is Assistant Director of Bands and Assistant Professor of Percussion at Auburn. He holds the Bachelor of Music degree from Louisiana State University, the Master of Music degree from the University of Miami, and is currently pursuing the Doctor of Musical Arts degree at the University of North Texas. At Auburn, he works with the Marching Band drumline, directs the Basketball Pep Band, Percussion Ensemble, Steel Band, and co-directs the Concert Band. In addition, he teaches all courses in percussion performance and percussion methods. Mr. Breaux has served as marching percussion instructor and arranger at each of the universities he has attended as well as for the Expressions Drum and Bugle Corps from Hammond, Louisiana. From 1993 to 1996 he was Associate Director of Bands at Seguin High School in Seguin, Texas. He has also served as a percussion specialist in the Colony and Lewisville School Districts in Texas. His professional affiliations include the Percussive Arts Society, Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, and Pi Kappa Lambda musical honor society.

**Dr. Rick Good** is Associate Director of Bands and Assistant Professor of Low Brass at Auburn. He received his Bachelor's degree in Music Education from Mansfield University in Pennsylvania, his Master of Music degree in Wind Conducting from Louisiana State University, and his Doctor of Musical Arts degree in Euphonium Performance from Arizona State University. Dr. Good is in his fifth year on the Auburn faculty. In addition to writing and teaching the drill to the AU Marching Band, his responsibilities include: directing the Concert Band and low brass ensembles, teaching marching band techniques, applied low brass, and low brass methods. Before coming to Auburn, Dr. Good was previously the Acting Associate Director of Bands at Arizona State University where he directed the Wind Ensemble, Concert Band, and Athletic Pep Bands. Dr. Good has taught in the public schools of Pennsylvania and Virginia. He has also performed professionally at Busch Gardens theme park in Virginia. Dr. Good hails from Allentown, Pennsylvania, which is affectionately known to many as "Band City, USA." He is active as a performer, clinician, and adjudicator throughout the country and holds memberships in various professional organizations.

**Dr. Johnnie Vinson** is Director of Bands and Professor of Music at Auburn. He holds both the Bachelor of Science and Master of Education degrees in Music Education from Auburn University, as well as the Doctor of the Arts degree in Music Theory from the University of Mississippi. Now in his twenty-ninth year on the Auburn faculty, Dr. Vinson previously served as Assistant Band Director, then Associate Band Director, and Director of the Marching Band before becoming Director of Bands in 1991. His job responsibilities include: supervising the total band program, working with the Marching Band, conducting the Symphonic Band, and teaching conducting, band literature, and band arranging. With over 250 published works, Dr. Vinson is a nationally recognized arranger / composer of music for band. He is also the author of "Arranging for the Marching Band", the first comprehensive college textbook on the subject. He is active professionally as a member and officer in numerous organizations. He presently serves as Past President of the Alabama Music Educators Association and is a former member of the Board of Directors of the National Band Association. In 1994, Dr. Vinson was elected to membership in the prestigious American Bandmasters Association, and in 1998 was elected to the Alabama Bandmasters Hall of Fame.

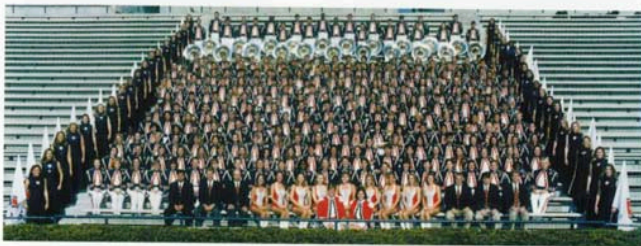
