CONDUCTORS

Stephen W. Pratt, Orchestra

Stephen W. Pratt is Professor of Music in the Indiana University Jacobs School of Music where he currently conducts the Wind Ensemble, teaches graduate conducting, and is chair of the Performance Coordinating Committee. He joined the Indiana University faculty in 1984 and was honored as a "faculty member of the highest distinction" in 1988 by the combined honor societies on campus. In 1993 he was the national recipient of The Distinguished Service to Music Medal awarded by Kappa Kappa Psi. In 2001 he was honored with the Outstanding University Music Educator Award, given by the Indiana Music Educators Association.

He is in constant demand as a guest conductor and clinician of orchestras and concert wind ensembles at the high school, collegiate and professional levels. He has recently conducted All-State Orchestras in Nevada and Kentucky and has conducted the IU Summer Music Clinic Symphony Orchestra a number of times. He was the music director and conductor of the Bloomington Symphony Orchestra from 1995-2000. Under his direction the orchestra was involved with a number of premiere performances and featured many eminent soloists, including Sarah Caswell, Corey Cerovsek, Leonard Hokanson, Howard Klug, Dominic Spera, and John Winninger as well as the Bloomington Chamber Singers. He was a founding member of the semi-professional Bloomington Pops Orchestra, and has guest conducted the group and performed as soloist many times. His CD recordings include several with the Bloomington Pops Orchestra and the Bloomington Oratorio Orchestra.

Eric M. Smedley, Crimson Band

Eric M. Smedley serves as Assistant Professor of Music and Assistant Director of Bands at the Indiana University Jacobs School of Music, where he directs the Concert Band, assists with the marching and athletic bands, and teaches undergraduate instrumental conducting. Dr. Smedley holds a Doctor of Musical Arts degree from the University of Washington and Master of Music and Bachelor of Music Education degrees from the Jacobs School of Music. He previously served on the music faculties of Boise State University and Western Kentucky University and as a public school music educator in Cocoa Beach, Fla., Santa Monica, Calif., and Kenosha, Wis.

Dr. Smedley has conducted throughout North America, Russia, and Japan. He maintains an active schedule as a clinician, guest conductor, and adjudicator. He also has an active schedule as a trumpet recitalist and ensemble musician, performing a wide variety of musical styles.

Scott Weiss, Cream Band

Scott Weiss is the Director of Bands and Sarah Bolick Smith Distinguished Professor of Music at the University of South Carolina where he conducts the USC Wind Ensemble, teaches and administers the graduate wind conducting program, and oversees all aspects of the university's band program. Previous positions include Director of Bands at the University of Kansas, Associate Director of Bands at the Indiana University Jacobs School of Music, and Director of Bands at Lamar University in Beaumont, Texas. He also has nine years of public school teaching experience, including six years as Director of Bands at Harrison High School in Cobb County, Georgia, where his wind ensemble was featured at the 1999 Midwest Clinic.

Scott Weiss maintains an active international guest conducting schedule, particularly in Asia where he has conducted wind ensembles and symphony orchestras in well over a dozen cities. Recent highlights include his June 2012 debut with the Shenzhen Symphony Orchestra, one of China's leading professional symphony orchestras, as well as a 2011 performance with the Shin-Siang Wind Ensemble at the National Concert Hall in Taipei. He has also taught and conducted ensembles at the Central Conservatory of Music in Beijing, the Shanghai Conservatory of Music, and Shanghai Jiao-Tong University, and in 2007 he was invited to give a conducting masterclass for the conductors of the People's Liberation Army of China Military Band in Beijing. In addition, he has presented research on wind band history and literature at the University of Luxembourg in 2008 and at the Austrian Wind Music Museum in Oberwölz, Austria in 2004. Closer to home, Scott Weiss regularly conducts all-state bands, intercollegiate bands, and high school honor bands throughout North America, and he has been featured as a guest conductor with both The United States Army Band ("Pershing's Own") and the United States Coast Guard Band.
